Legislative Terminology:

The Congressional Budget Office (CBO)- CBO is a legislative branch agency that produces independent analyses of budgetary and economic issues to support the Congressional budget process.

Congressional Research Service (CRS) of the Library of Congress- CRS works exclusively for the United States Congress, providing policy and legal analysis to committees and Members of both the House and Senate, regardless of party affiliation. CRS provides Congress with analysis that is authoritative, confidential, objective, and non-partisan.

Federal Depository Library – Libraries where congressional and other federal publications are available for free public use.

Government Publishing Office (GPO) - GPO is a legislative branch agency that provides publishing and dissemination services for the official and authentic government publications to Congress, federal agencies, federal depository libraries, and the American public.

Today, members of the State Assembly and Senate convened for the 2021 Organizational Session. Largely ceremonial, today's session primarily allowed for the swearing-in of new and returning members of the Legislature. While a handful of bills will be introduced, members were mainly just here for the day and will now return home to their districts for the holidays.

The 2021-22 Legislative session will officially begin on Monday, January 4, and will have a total of 18 new members across the two houses – 10 in the Assembly, 8 in the Senate. Below, please find the individual names of all 18 new members:
